On 12/31/2017 at approximately 6:00 PM the victim, a 31 year old female from Budd Lake hired Uber Driver, Reginald Brown for a car service. Upon completion of the service, an argument ensued between the parties and Mr. Brown brandished a knife. Mr. Brown was later contacted by police and subsequently responded to the police station for further investigation. At headquarters, Mr. Brown consented to a search of his motor vehicle. A knife matching the description was located in his vehicle. Mr. Brown was charged with Harassment, and released pending a court hearing.

On 12/31/2017 at 3:48 PM, Officer William Galop was dispatched to a hit and run motor vehicle accident on Route 46 near the lake. A witness reported the license plate of the vehicle that left the scene of the accident. Officer Galop located the suspect vehicle, a black Chevy pickup, parked in Equity Plaza. He made contact with the driver, Gregory Harrison. Officer Galop noticed obvious signs of impairment and requested Mr. Harrison perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon completion of his investigation, Officer Galop placed Mr. Harrison under arrest for Driving While Under the Influence of Alcohol. Mr. Harrison was transported to headquarters for processing. Mr. Harrison submitted to Chemical Breath Testing and was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Careless Driving and Failure to Report an Accident. He was released to a sober driver, pending a court hearing.

On 12/31/2017 at 12:33 AM, Officer Michael Carletta responded to the area of 72 Winding Hill Drive for a motor vehicle accident with air bag deployment. Upon his arrival, he observed a black Chrysler sedan involved in an accident. It was determined that Ms. Doreen Castrovilla-Faulconbridge was driving the vehicle involved in the crash. After determining that Ms. Castrovilla-Faulconbridge was not injured in the crash, Officer Carletta noticed obvious signs of impairment and requested Ms. Castrovilla-Faulconbridge perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon completion of the tests, Ms. Castrovilla-Faulconbridge was placed under arrest for DWI and was transported to headquarters for processing. At police headquarters, Ms. Castrovilla-Faulconbridge refused to submit to Chemical Breath Testing. She was subsequently charged with DWI, Refusal to Submit to Breath Samples, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain a Lane and Failure to Report an Accident. On 12/30/2017 at 12:57 PM, Officer Gina Inga responded to the area of 123 Winding Hill Drive for the report of multiple mailboxes struck by a possible drunk driver. Upon arrival, Officer Inga observed a white van with mailboxes up against it and underneath it. Officer Inga made contact with the driver, Mr. Robert Traetta who had obvious signs of impairment due to being under the influence of alcohol. Mr. Traetta was unable to safely perform standardized field sobriety tests due to his condition and the snow and ice conditions on the roadways. Mr. Traetta was transported to headquarters for processing. At headquarters, Mr. Traetta was asked to perform standardized field sobriety tests, and again, due to his condition, the tests could not be completed. Mr. Traetta submitted to Chemical Breath Testing. He was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain a Lane and Failure to Report an Accident. He was released pending a court hearing.

On 12/29/2017 at 9:55 PM, Detective Hunter Guiles was on supplemental DWI patrol, "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" when he observed a white Chevy Silverado travelling on Route 46 with an inoperative passenger side head light. Detective Guiles pulled the vehicle over and made contact with the driver, identified as Paul Diguieseppi. Mr. Diguieseppi showed obvious signs of impairment as he interacted with Detective Guiles. Detective Guiles asked Mr. Diguieseppi to exit the vehicle to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon completion of investigation, Mr. Diguieseppi was placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. Mr. Diguieseppi submitted to Chemical Breath Testing. He was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain Lamps, Failure to Exhibit Documents. On 12/29/2017 at 7:29 PM Officer Anthony Gardner responded to a motor vehicle accident on Old Budd Lake Road. Upon his arrival he observed a Kia Sorento into the woods and a telephone pole snapped in half and hanging over the roadway. When Officer Gardner approached the vehicle, he made contact with the driver, Ida Lozirk who showed obvious signs of impairment. Ms. Lozirk advised she was not injured, but her passenger appeared to be injured. Officer Gardner summoned Budd Lake First Aid for an unresponsive 50 year old female passenger. The passenger was taken for treatment at a local hospital with injuries. Officer Gardner completed his investigation at the scene and Ms. Lozirk was arrested and transported to headquarters for processing. At headquarters, Ms. Lozirk submitted to Chemical Breath Testing. Ms. Lozirk was charged with Assault by Auto, DWI, Possession of Marijuana under 50 Grams, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Failure to Maintain a Lane, Possession of CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Ms. Lozirk was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing. Morris County Sheriff C.I.D. responded to assist with the crash investigation.

Upon completion of the investigation, Mr. Traetta was placed under arrest for DWI and transported to headquarters for processing. At headquarters, Mr. Traetta submitted to Chemical Breath Testing. Mr. Traetta was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Parked in a No Parking Zone. Mr. Traetta released pending a court hearing.
