Incident/Event:	Unlawful Possession of a Handgun

On January 19, 2018 at 12:08 am, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 1998 Toyota make a left turn from Rt. 46 west onto International Drive South utilizing the straight only lanes, not the left turn lane. Officer Spotts initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Toyota in the area of the Shell Gas Station. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Surovey. As Officer Spotts spoke with Ms. Surovey she advised that she was in possession of a handgun in a bag in her rear seat. Ms. Surovey also advised that she had a license to carry a concealed handgun from Ohio. Ms. Surovey was asked to exit the vehicle, and subsequently a loaded Glock handgun was retrieved from the area where Ms. Surovey had indicated. Ms. Surovey's license to carry was determined to not include NJ. Ms. Surovey was subsequently placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Surovey was lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.

Incident/Event:	Disorderly Conduct

On January 19, 2018 at 5:04 pm, Officer Gardner responded to the Village Green outside of building 11 for the report of a fall victim. When Officer Gardner arrived he located the victim, identified as Ms. Kulik, standing on the sidewalk. Ms. Kulik had fallen, and sustained minor abrasions to her face. An ambulance was called to examine Ms. Kulik, and Ms. Kulik refused medical aid.

Alongside of Ms. Kulik was a Village Green Maintenance truck, occupied by a Village Green Maintenance worker. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that Ms. Kulik was visiting a residence, and had locked herself out. When Ms. Kulik requested assistance from Village Green Maintenance to regain entry to the residence, she was denied because she was not listed on the lease. Ms. Kulik then reportedly struck the maintenance worker. Officer Gardner spoke with Ms. Kulik, and as he did so detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her person, and Ms. Kulik appeared to be impaired. Ms. Kulik behaved in a continually aggressive and abusive manor, and was subsequently placed under arrest for disorderly conduct. Ms. Kulik was transported to police headquarters, where she was charged with Disorderly Conduct. Ms. Kulik was released pending a court hearing.

On January 19, 2018 at 11:30 pm, Officer Jadue was on routine patrol when he observed a 2005 Audi traveling east on Rt. 46 in front of Officer Jadue's patrol vehicle. A random inquiry of the Audi's registration showed the registration was expired. Officer Jadue initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Audi in the area of Old Budd Lake Rd. Officer Jadue made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Puig. As Officer Jadue spoke with Mr. Puig he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Mr. Puig was asked to exit the vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded a container of suspected marijuana. Mr. Puig was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Puig was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, and Unregistered Motor Vehicle. Mr. Puig was released pending a court hearing.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
