Incident/Event:	Possession of False Government Documents, Hindering own Apprehension

On January 24, 2018 at 11:25 pm, Officer Reynolds was on routine patrol when he observed a 2005 Subaru traveling on Rt. 46 fail to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Reynolds initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Subaru in the area of Church Street. Officer Reynolds made contact with the driver, who identified himself Eduin Trochez. Officer Reynolds asked the driver to provide him with identification, and while the driver was looking through his wallet, Officer Reynolds observed Permanent Resident card in his wallet. Officer Reynolds asked to see the card, and on closer inspection determined that the card, which had the name Eduin Trochez on it, was fraudulent. The driver was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. The driver was fingerprinted, and the fingerprints identified the driver as Edwin Trocheenomarsdo. Mr. Trocheenomarsdo was charged with Possession of False Government Documents, Hindering Own Apprehension, Unlicensed Driver, Failure to Maintain Lane, and Maintenance of Lamps. Mr. Trocheenomarsdo was released pending a court hearing.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
