On January 25, 2018 at 3:38 pm, Officer Mullooly responded to a residence on Netcong Rd. to check on the welfare of a female, identified as Alexa Disabato, who was reported to be staying there. Officer Mullooly was initially unable to make contact with Ms. Disabato at the residence. Officer Mullooly remained in the area, and a short time later observed two females in the backyard of the residence. Officer Mullooly stepped out with the females, and identified them as Ms. Disabato and Ms. Brittany Mojak. A check of both parties' credentials showed active no bail warrants for Ms. Disabato's and Ms. Mojak's arrest out of Morris County Sheriff's Office. Both Ms. Disabato and Ms. Mojak were placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Both parties were lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.

On January 25, 2018 at 6:28 pm, Officer Slinger responded to the intersection of River Road and Bartley Road for the report of a motor vehicle accident. The driver of a 2002 Dodge pulled into the intersection off of River Rd. into the path of a 2006 Lexus, which was traveling on Bartley Rd. Officer Slinger made contact with both drivers, and determined that there were no injuries associated with the crash. The driver of the Dodge was identified as Mr. Delamaterperkoski. As Officer Slinger spoke with Mr. Delamaterperkoski he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Delamaterperkoski appeared to be impaired. Officer Slinger observed, in plain view, an open container of alcohol in the vehicle. Mr. Delamaterperkoski was asked to perform field sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. Mr. Delamaterperkoski was transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Delamaterperkoski was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Open Alcoholic Container in a Motor Vehicle, Consumption of Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle, and Failure to Yield Right of Way. Mr. Delamaterperkoski was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On January 25, 2018 at 11:16 pm, Officer Slinger responded to the holiday Inn for the report of a disturbance. The hotel employee advised that there was a male who was playing loud music and writing on hotel property with a marker. When Officer Slinger arrived he located the male, later identified as Mr. Kosak outside of the lobby. When Mr. Kosak saw Officer Slinger, he turned and re-entered the hotel, stopping at the elevators. As Officer Slinger attempted to speak with Mr. Kosak, Mr. Kosak began to yell expletives, and refused to comply with Officer Slinger's directions. Officer Jadue and Cpl. Rossy arrived to assist, and Mr. Kosak spit at the officers, striking Officer Jadue in the leg. As the officers attempted to place Mr. Kosak under arrest, he began to fight and attempt to bite the officers. Mr. Kosak was sprayed with OC spray, and was then able to be placed in handcuffs. Mr. Kosak was subsequently transported to police headquarters where he was charged with Aggravated Assault on Law Enforcement, Throwing Bodily Fluid at Law Enforcement, Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct. Mr. Kosak was transported to Saint Clare's Hospital for evaluation, and released pending a court hearing.
