Incident/Event:	Possession of Marijuana Under 50 Grams, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

On 2/4/2018 at 1:08 AM, Officer James Carney was on patrol when he observed a blue Pontiac travelling Route 46 west and failing to maintain a lane. Officer Carney initiated a motor vehicle stop on Route 46, near Elizabeth Lane. Officer Carney made contact with the driver and the passenger. Officer Gregory Slinger arrived on the scene to assist Officer Carney. The passenger of the vehicle refused to identify himself to the officers. Officer Slinger recognized the passenger from previous encounters. The passenger was identified as Kyle J. Sallie. It was believed that Mr. Sallie had an active NCIC warrant for his arrest. Mr. Sallie was placed under arrest and searched incident to arrest and a small Ziploc bag of suspected marijuana was located in his jeans pocket. Mr. Sallie was transported to headquarters for processing. While at headquarters, it was determined that the NCIC warrant did not match Mr. Sallie. Mr. Sallie was charged with Possession of Marijuana Under 50 Grams, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was released pending a court hearing.

On 2/5/2018 at 1:24 AM Officer Michael Carletta was dispatched to a disabled motor vehicle on Treetop Road, in Budd Lake. Upon arrival, Officer Carletta observed several vehicles having difficulty driving up the hill due to icy conditions. Officer Carletta noticed a vehicle attempt to drive up the hill, but stopped after it passed the parked patrol vehicle. Officer Carletta approached the vehicle to speak to the driver. Upon speaking to the driver, identified as William Legault, he noticed signs of impairment. Mr. Legault was asked to exit the vehicle for further investigation. Mr. Legault was led to a safe location to perform standardized field sobriety tests on a level surface without ice. Mr. Legault was subsequently placed under arrest for DWI. He was transported to headquarters for processing where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Legault was charged with DWI and Reckless Driving. He was released to a sober driver pending a court appearance.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
