On February 8, 2018 at 7:05 pm, Officer Reynolds was on routine patrol when he observed a 1997 Subaru traveling west on Rt. 46 traveling at a high rate of speed. Officer Reynolds initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Subaru in the area of the Budd Lake Fire Department. Officer Reynolds made contact with the vehicle's occupants. The driver was identified as Mr. Lamboy, and the passenger as Mr. Rohr. As Officer Reynolds spoke with the men, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. A check of Mr. Rohr's credentials showed an active warrant for his arrest for \$450.00 out of Kearney, NJ. Mr. Rohr was placed under arrest. Mr. Lamboy was asked to exit the vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded two baggies of suspected marijuana. Mr. Lamboy was placed under arrest, and both parties were transported to police headquarters. Mr. Lamboy was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Speeding. He was released pending a court hearing. Mr. Rohr was unable to post bail, and was turned over to Kearney Police on the warrant.

On February 8, 2018 at 7:09 pm, Officer Slinger was on routine patrol when he observed a 2000 Lexus traveling west on Rt. 46 fail to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Slinger initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Lexus in the area of Equity Plaza. Officer Slinger made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Schmidt. A check of Mr. Schmidt's credentials showed an active warrant for Mr. Schmidt's arrest for \$750.00 out of Denville, NJ. Mr. Schmidt was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Schmidt was unable to post bail, and was subsequently turned over to the Denville Police on the warrant.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
