On February 12, 2018 at 2:42 pm, Cpl. Rossy was on routine patrol when he observed a 2008 Honda traveling east on Rt. 46 at a high rate of speed. Cpl. Rossy initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Honda in the area of the Shell Gas Station. Cpl. Rossy made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez. As Cpl. Rossy spoke with Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez was asked to step out of the vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded a plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana, and a plastic baggie containing a suspected marijuana cigarette. Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, Speeding, Careless Driving, Unlicensed Driver, and CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Ms. Bencosme-Jimenez was released pending a court hearing.

On February 13, 2018 at 12:55 am, Officer Mullooly was on routine patrol when he observed a 2007 Chevrolet traveling west on Rt. 46 fail to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Mullooly initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Chevrolet in the area of Village Way. Officer Mullooly made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Prevost. As Officer Mullooly spoke with Mr. Prevost he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Prevost appeared to be impaired. Mr. Prevost was asked to exit his vehicle and perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Prevost was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he refused to submit to chemical breath testing. Mr. Prevost was charged with DWI, Refusal to Submit to Chemical Breath Testing, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain Lane, Careless Driving, Improper Turns, Failure to Signal Turn, and Failure to Exhibit Registration. Mr. Prevost was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.
