On February 14, 2018 at 12:40 am, Officer Reynolds was on routine patrol when he observed a 2006 Kia traveling west on Rt. 46. A random inquiry of the Kia's registration showed that it was expired. Officer Reynolds initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Kia in the area of the Budd Lake Fire House. The driver of the Kia was identified as Mr. Manley. A check of Mr. Manley's credentials showed that he was unlicensed, and had an active no bail warrant for his arrest out of the Warren County Sheriff's Office. As Officer Reynolds spoke with Mr. Manley, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Mr. Manley was placed under arrest, and a subsequent search of the vehicle yielded a plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana. Mr. Manley was transported to police headquarters and was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, and possession of CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Mr. Manley was turned over to the Warren County Sheriff's Officer on the warrant.

On February 13, 2018 at approximately 9:30 am, a male suspect forced entry into a residence in the Flanders section of Mt. Olive. The male kicked in the rear door and entered the residence, removing multiple items from the master bedroom. Items taken include jewelry, silver coins and silver bars, a Russian-made night vision scope/range finder and handgun ammunition in a fire safe.
