On February 16, 2018 at 12:40 pm, Officer Jadue responded to North Mt. Olive Road for the report of a parking complaint. When Officer Jadue arrived in the area he observed a male, who Officer Jadue recognized to be Mr. Dulio, on the front porch of the residence. A check of Mr. Dulio's credentials showed an active no bail warrant for Mr. Dulio's arrest out of Morris County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Dulio was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he was subsequently turned over to the Morris County Sheriff's Office on the warrant.

On February 16, 2018 at 6:00 pm, Officer Jadue responded to the area of Rt. 46 and Church Street for the report of two car motor vehicle accident, with one vehicle, a 2003 BMW, overturned in the roadway. The second vehicle involved, a 2010 Toyota, had heavy front end damage. Officer Jadue made contact with the driver of the Toyota who advised that she was uninjured. The driver of the BMW was entrapped in the vehicle, and had to be extricated by the Budd Lake Fire Department. The driver of the BMW was identified as Mr. Clymer. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that the BMW struck the curb as it was traveling west on Rt. 46, overturned, and traveled into the east bound lanes of the highway, where it collided with the Toyota. Once Mr. Clymer was extricated from the vehicle, Officer Jadue observed him to be impaired, specifically under the influence of a narcotic. Mr. Clymer was treated at the scene by Atlantic EMS and St. Clare's Hospital Paramedics. Mr. Clymer was transported to Hackettstown Medical Center, where he was treated for minor injuries.

Once Mr. Clymer was discharged from the hospital, he was transported to police headquarters. Mr. Clymer was charged with Under the Influence of CDS, DWI, Reckless Driving, and Failure to Maintain a Lane. Mr. Clymer was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
