On February 22, 2018 at 9:54 pm, Officer Gardner responded to a residence in Flanders for the report of a missing juvenile. When Officer Gardner arrived, the JM's parents advised that their son had left the residence sometime during the course of the day, and has not returned. Through the course of the investigation the JM was located at a residence on Devonshire Terrace along with a second male who was identified as Dominic Moyano. As Officer Gardner spoke with both Dominic and the JM, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from within the residence. Both Dominic and the JM also appeared to be under the influence of marijuana. A consent search of the residence yielded a baggie containing suspected marijuana, two grinders containing suspected marijuana residue, a pipe containing suspected marijuana residue, rolling papers, and a marijuana cigarette. Both Dominic and the JM were placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Dominic Moyano was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, and Under the Influence of CDS. He was released pending a court hearing. The JM was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, and Under the Influence of CDS. The JM was released to a parent pending a meeting with the Juvenile Detective.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
