On February 23, 2018 at 11:13 pm, Cpl. Cuff was on routine patrol when he observed a 2000 Toyota turn from Woodsedge Ave. onto Rt. 46 west without utilizing a turn signal, then fail to maintain its lane of travel on Rt. 46. Cpl. Cuff initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Toyota in the area of Evergreen Parkway. Cpl. Cuff made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Capavanni. As Officer Cuff spoke with Ms. Capavanni, he note that she appeared to be extremely nervous. Ms. Capavanni was asked to exit her vehicle to speak further with Cpl. Cuff. When Ms. Capavanni exited the vehicle, Cpl. Cuff observed a pill bottle lying on the driver side floor. The bottle contained multiple pills identified as Amphetamine. A search of the vehicle produced three additional Amphetamine pills. Ms. Capavanni was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Capavanni was charged with Possession of CDS Schedule I-IV, Possession of Paraphernalia, Failure to Signal Turn, Failure to Maintain Lane, Possession of CDS in a Motor Vehicle, Failure to Exhibit Registration, and Failure to Exhibit Insurance. Ms. Capavanni was released pending a court hearing.

On February 25, 2018 at 1:17 am, Officer Galop was on routine patrol when he observed a 2002 Kia traveling west on Rt. 46 with an inoperative headlight. Officer Galop initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Kia in the area of Cove Street. Officer Galop made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Hansford. As Officer Galop spoke with Mr. Hansford he noted that Mr. Hansford appeared to be impaired. Mr. Hansford was asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Hansford was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Hansford was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Under the Influence of CDS, Maintenance of Lamps, Failure to Exhibit Registration, and Failure to Exhibit Insurance. Mr. Hansford was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On February 25, 2018 at 9:32 pm, Officer Anderson responded to a residence on Alden Terrace for the anonymous tip that there was a male at the residence with multiple active warrants for his arrest. When Officer Anderson arrived at the residence, he was able to locate the male, identified as Mr. Conklin, hiding in a downstairs room in the residence. Mr. Conklin was taken into custody without incident. Mr. Conklin had two no bail warrants for his arrest out of the Warren County Sheriff's Office and the Sussex County Sheriff's Office, as well as multiple other warrants totaling \$1,500.00. Mr. Conklin was transported to police headquarters, where he was turned over to the Warren County Sheriff's Office on the warrant.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
