On March 9, 2018 at 10:38 pm, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 2001 Jeep traveling west on Sand Shore Rd. A random inquiry of the Jeep's registration showed that it was expired. Officer Spotts conducted a motor vehicle stop of the Jeep in the area of Woodcrest Ave. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver of the vehicle, who was identified as Ms. Settineri. As Ms. Settineri was looking through her wallet to provide Officer Spotts with her NJ driver's license, Officer Spotts observed a Pennsylvania Driver's license also within the wallet. Through the course of the investigation, Ms. Settineri was found to be in possession of two falsified Pennsylvania driver's licenses. Ms. Settineri was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Settineri was charged with Possession of False Government Documents, Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and Maintenance of Lamps. Ms. Settineri was released pending a court hearing.

On March 10, 2018 at 2:35 pm, Cpl. Cuff was on routine patrol when he observed a 2002 Buick traveling west on Rt. 46, traveling too closely to the vehicle in front of it. Cpl. Cuff initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Buick in the area of the Budd Lake Beach. Cpl. Cuff made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Vanorden. As Cpl. Cuff spoke with Ms. Vanorden he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Ms. Vanorden and a passenger were asked to exit the vehicle and a search was conducted. The search yielded a glass pipe containing suspected partially smoked marijuana. Ms. Vanorden was also found to be in possession of a hypodermic syringe. Ms. Vanorden was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Vanorden was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, Possession of a Hypodermic Syringe, Tailgating, Driving While Suspended, and Possession of CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Ms. Vanorden was released pending a court hearing.

On March 11, 2018 at 1:54 am, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 2011 Ford fail to stop at the stop sign as it turned from Love Lane onto Rt. 46 west. Officer Spotts initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Ford in the area of International Drive. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Brooks. As Officer Spotts spoke with Mr. Brooks he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Brooks appeared to be impaired. Mr. Brooks was asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Brooks was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Brooks was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Stop, Failure to Keep Right, Failure to Maintain Lane, Failure to Signal Turn, Obstructed View, Failure to Exhibit Registration, and Failure to Exhibit Insurance. Mr. Brooks was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On March 13, 2018 at 1:05 am, Officer Carletta was on routine patrol when he observed a 2010 Toyota traveling south on Rt. 206 at a high rate of speed. Officer Carletta initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Toyota in the area of Deerfield Place. Officer Carletta made contact with the driver of the vehicle, who was identified as Ms. Miller. As Officer Carletta spoke with Ms. Miller he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. During the course of the investigation, Ms. Miller was found to be in possession of a glass jar containing suspected marijuana. Ms. Miller was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Miller was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Speeding. Ms. Miller was released pending a court hearing.
