On April 29, 2017 at 2:57 am, Officer Koppinger was on routine patrol when he observed a 2007 Mitsubishi stopped on the shoulder of Rt. 206 south with its hazard lights flashing. Officer Koppinger stopped behind the Mitsubishi, and made contact with the vehicle passengers. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Ms. Matis, and the passenger as Mr. Keenan. As Officer Koppinger spoke with Ms. Matis and Mr. Keenan he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Ms. Matis and Mr. Keenan were asked to step out of the vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded a plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana, a metal grinder containing suspected marijuana residue, and a glass pipe containing suspected marijuana residue. Both Ms. Matis and Mr. Keenan were placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Matis was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Suspended Registration. Mr. Keenan was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. Both Ms. Matis and Mr. Keenan were released pending a court hearing.

On May 1, 2017 at 9:37 am, Officer Spotts responded to the area of Eagle Rock Village to attempt to locate Mr. Hartman, who has an active warrant for his arrest for \$3835.00 out of Roxbury Twp. Officer Spotts was able to locate Mr. Hartman, and take him into custody without incident. Mr. Hartman was transported to police headquarters, and was subsequently turned over to Roxbury Police for the warrant.

On May 2, 2017 at 1:49 am, Sgt. Zarro was on routine patrol when he observed grey Chevrolet with a non-functioning headlight traveling west on Rt. 80. Sgt. Zarro initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Chevrolet in the area of exit 25. Sgt. Zarro made contact with the vehicle occupants. The driver was identified as Mr. Mushialov, and the passengers were identified as Mr. Manakhim and Mr. Shumshumov. As Sgt. Zarro spoke with the occupants, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. All occupants were asked to exit the vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded a plastic baggie of suspected marijuana. All three men were placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Mushailov was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, Possession of CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Maintenance of Lamps. Mr. Manakhim was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. Mr. Manakhim was found to have an active warrant for \$639.00 out of Linden, NJ. Mr. Manakhim was able to post bail for the warrant. Mr. Shumshumov was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. All parties were released pending a court hearing.
