Mothers Against Drunk Driving in cooperation with the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety; will be hosting a statewide recognition ceremony on June 14<sup>th</sup>. The annual ceremony, "Saving Lives by Preventing Crashes", honors officers state wide for their proactive endeavors in enforcing the D.W.I. laws for the prior year. The Mount Olive Police Department is pleased to announce that five (5) Mount Olive Township Police Officers will be amongst those receiving such recognition. Those five officers are Patrolmen William Galop, Andrew Spotts, Lonnie Elbaum, Mark Reynolds, and Michael Carletta. Chief Stephen Beecher said:

*"Approximately 1/3 of all traffic fatalities are caused by impaired drivers and in those crashes about ten thousand (10,000) people die annually. The Mount Olive Township Police arrested one hundred eleven (111) people in 2016 for impaired driving. The honored officers accounted for sixty five (65) of those arrests. We are proud of our police department's work to save lives, and in particular the efforts of Officers Galop, Spotts, Elbaum, Reynolds and Carletta. "*
