On 8/17/2017 at 11:23 PM Officer Gina Inga was on patrol on Route 46 in Budd Lake when she observed a grey GMC pickup truck with an inoperable license plate light and the vehicle was failing to maintain a lane of travel. Officer Inga stopped the vehicle on Route 46 east of Old Wolfe Road. She made contact with the driver, Kenneth Beers, 3rd when she noticed obvious signs of impairment. During the course of the motor vehicle stop, Ms. Jackalyn Bolcar asked Officer Inga if she could exit the vehicle. Officer Inga received consent to search the vehicle from Mr. Beers, which yielded prescription drugs, not prescribed to him. Mr. Beers was asked to perform standardized field sobriety tests. Mr. Beers was subsequently placed under arrest for driving while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia was located on Ms. Bolcar's person. Mr. Beers and Ms. Bolcar were transported to headquarters for processing. Sergeant Pat McNichol, a certified Drug Recognition Expert from Mendham Borough Police Department responded to headquarters to assist Officer Inga. Mr. Beers was charged with DWI, possession of CDS in a motor vehicle, Failure to Maintain Lamps, Failure to Maintain a Lane, Reckless Driving, Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Drug paraphernalia, Possession of Prescription Legend Drug and

Being Under the Influence of a Controlled Dangerous Substance. Ms. Bolcar was charged with Possession of Methamphetamine, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Mr. Beers and Ms. Bolcar were released pending a court hearing.

On 8/18/2017 at 8:34 PM Officer Reynolds was dispatched to a one car rollover accident which occurred on Drakestown Road. Officer Reynolds arrived on scene and observed the driver, Adam Clymer was out of the vehicle, the vehicle was on its side and it struck a telephone pole when it came to rest. Upon further investigation, Mr. Clymer was asked to perform field standardized field sobriety tests. Mr. Clymer was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. Mr. Clymer submitted to chemical breath testing and Officer Chad Rossy, a certified Drug Recognition Expert completed an evaluation on Mr. Clymer. Mr. Clymer was charged with driving while under the influence of alcohol and/or Drugs, Being under the Influence of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, Reckless Driving and Failure to Maintain a Lane. He was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing

On 8/20/2017 at 12:04 AM Officer Bill Galop was on patrol on Route 46, Budd Lake when he observed a black BMW driving Route 46 East at a high rate of speed. Officer Galop stopped the vehicle near Mount Olive Road and made contact with the driver, Richard Notillo. While Mr. Notillo was gathering his documents for Officer Galop, Officer Galop observed a clear plastic bag containing suspected marijuana in Mr. Notillo's wallet. Mr. Notillo was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. Mr. Notillo was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Speeding. Mr. Notillo was released pending a court hearing.

On August 20, 2017 at 11:31 PM, Officer Matt Koppinger and Officer Chad Rossy responded to an apartment on Brock Lane for an unresponsive male. Upon Officer Koppinger's arrival, he observed the male to be face down and only breathing shallow breaths. Officer Koppinger deployed oxygen while Officer Rossy prepared and administered Nasal Narcan to the victim. St. Clare's Paramedics arrived on scene and administered a second dose of Nasal Narcan to the victim, to which he responded and recovered.
