On October 4, 2017 at 4:14 pm, Officer Galop was on routine patrol when he observed a 2006 Ford traveling south on International Drive South at a high rate of speed. Officer Galop initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Ford in the area of Walmart. Officer Galop made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Wiltshire. As Officer Galop spoke with Mr. Wiltshire he noted that Mr. Wiltshire appeared to be impaired. Mr. Wiltshire was asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. During the course of the investigation, Mr. Wiltshire was found to be in possession of multiple syringes and a glassine fold containing suspected heroin. Mr. Wiltshire was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Wiltshire was charged with DWI, Possession of CDS Schedule I-IV, Possession of Paraphernalia, Possession of a Hypodermic Syringe, Reckless Driving, CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Speeding. Mr. Wiltshire was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On October 5, 2017 at 12:04 am, Officer Carney was on routine patrol when he observed a 2013 Chevrolet traveling south on Rt. 206 at a high rate of speed. Officer Carney initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Chevrolet in the area of Mt. Olive Exxon. Officer Carney made contact with the vehicle occupants, and the passenger was identified as Ms. Suarez. A check of Ms. Suarez's credentials showed an active no bail warrant for Ms. Suarez's arrest out of Atlantic County Sheriff's Office. Ms. Suarez was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where she was turned over to the Atlantic County Sheriff's Office on the warrant.

On October 5, 2017 at 3:30 am, Officer Carney was on routine patrol when he observed a 2003 Honda traveling west on Rt. 46 fail to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Carney initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Honda in the area of Subaru 46. Officer Carney made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Alston. As Officer Carney spoke with Ms. Alston, he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. During the course of the investigation, Ms. Alston was found to be in possession of a plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana and a partially smoked marijuana cigarette. Ms. Alston was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Alston was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, Failure to Maintain Lane, and CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Ms. Alston was released pending a court hearing.
