On October 21, 2017 at 4:49 pm, Officer Saunders was on routine patrol when he observed a 2012 Nissan traveling north on Rt. 206 with the passengers not wearing seatbelts. Officer Saunders initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Nissan in the area of Chestnut Way. Officer Saunders made contact with the vehicle occupants, and observed a child seated on the lap of a rear seat passenger. The front seat passenger was identified as Ms. Conception, and the rear passenger as Mr. Conception. A check of Ms. Conception's credentials showed an active warrant for her arrest for \$250.00 out of Hoboken, NJ. A check of Mr. Conception's credentials showed an active no bail warrant for his arrest out of Hudson County Sheriff's Office. Both parties were placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Conception was able to post, and was released pending a court hearing. Mr. Conception was turned over to the Hudson County Sheriff's Office on the warrant.

On October 22, 2017 at 5:31 pm, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 2014 Kawasaki motorcycle traveling west on Rt. 46. A random inquiry of the motorcycle's registration came back listed as not on file. Officer Spotts conducted a motor vehicle stop of the motorcycle in the area of Joy Drive. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver, who identified himself as Mr. David Serra. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that the male was Mr. Carlos Jaco, who was unlicensed, and had multiple warrants for his arrest totaling \$3,750.00 out of Rockaway Boro, NJ and Stanhope, NJ. Mr. Jaco was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Jaco was charged with Hindering Own Apprehension, Unlicensed Driver, Fictitious Plates, Uninsured Motor Vehicle, Driving an Unregistered Vehicle, Driving While Suspended, and Failure to Exhibit Driver's License or identification. Mr. Jaco was subsequently turned over to Rockaway Boro on the warrants.

On October 22, 2017 at 5:35 pm, Officer Galop responded to a room at the Extended Stay America as part on an investigation. While in the room, Officer Galop observed in plain view, a baggie containing suspected marijuana. Through the course of the investigation, the marijuana was found to belong to a male in the room, identified as Mr. Finnegan. Mr. Finnegan was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Finnegan was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. Mr. Finnegan was released pending a court hearing.
