On November 4, 2017 at 5:29 pm, Officer Spotts was conducting a business check of Kennedy's Budd Lake Motel when he made contact with a female whom he recognized as Ms. Taylor. A check of Mr. Taylor's credentials showed multiple active warrants for Ms. Taylor's arrest including a no bail warrant out of the Morris County Prosecutor's Office. Ms. Taylor was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Taylor was subsequently turned over to the Morris County Prosecutor's Officer on the warrant.

On November 5, 2017 at 1:04 am, Officer Carletta was on routine patrol when he observed a 2017 Subaru traveling east on Rt. 46 at a high rate of speed. Officer Carletta initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Subaru in the area of Old Wolfe Rd. Officer Carletta made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Cedenoneira. As Officer Carletta spoke with Mr. Cedenoneira he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Cedenoneira appeared to be impaired. Mr. Cedenoneira was asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Cedenoneira was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Cedenoneira was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Speeding, and Failure to Maintain Lane. Mr. Cedenoneira was turned over to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On November 5, 2017 at 11:04 pm, Officer Mullooly responded to the parking lot of the Super 8 Motel for the report of an unresponsive male located in a 2000 Chevrolet in the parking lot. Officer Mullooly located the vehicle, with the male victim in the backseat. Standing outside of the Chevrolet was a male who was identified as Mr. Shaffer. First aid was rendered to the unresponsive male, and care of the male was subsequently turned over to the Budd Lake Rescue Squad. The investigation that followed determined that there were two loaded handguns and a box of hollow point bullets in the vehicle. It was determined that the handguns and bullets belonged to Mr. Shaffer. Mr. Shaffer was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Shaffer was charged with Unlawful Possession of a Handgun and Possession of Hollow Point Bullets. Mr. Shaffer was lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
