On November 16, 2017 at 12:23 pm, Officer Reynolds responded to a residence in Budd Lake to attempt to locate a female identified as Ms. Demaria, who was known to have an active warrant for her arrest for \$500.00 out of Parsippany, NJ. Officer Reynolds located Ms. Demaria inside of the residence. Ms. Demaria was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Demaria was unable to post, and was subsequently turned over to Parsippany Police in lieu of bail.

On November 16, 2017 at 2:34 pm, Detective Pagonis was on routine patrol when he observed a male walking along Wolfe Road throw a paper bag on the ground. Detective Pagonis stepped out with the male, who was identified as Mr. Todd. A check of Mr. Todd's credentials showed an active warrant for Mr. Todd's arrest for \$700.00 out of Washington Twp. NJ. Mr. Todd was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. A search of Mr. Todd's person produced foil paper containing a tab of suspected LSD. Mr. Todd was charged with Possession of CDS Schedule I-IV. Mr. Todd was unable to post bail, and was lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.

On November 17, 2017 at 12:33 pm, Officer Carletta was on routine patrol in the parking lot of Walmart when he observed Mr. Gray, whom Officer Carletta is familiar with, exiting his vehicle in the parking lot. Officer Carletta stepped out with Mr. Gray and a check of Mr. Gray's credentials showed active warrants for his arrest totaling \$304.00 out of Irvington, NJ. Mr. Gray was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Gray was able to post bail, and was released pending a court hearing. Officer Carletta checked the credentials of a female, identified as Ms. McGill, who was with Mr. Gray at Walmart at the time of his arrest. The check showed an active no bail warrant for Ms. McGill's arrest out of Middlesex County Sheriff's Office. Officer Carletta located Ms. McGill at Mr. Gray's residence. Ms. McGill was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Ms. McGill was subsequently turned over to the Middlesex County Sheriff's Department on the warrant.

On November 18, 2017 at 11:29 pm, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 2010 Honda traveling west on Rt. 46 fail to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Spotts initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Honda in the area of Sinclair Gas Station. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Mullin. As Officer Spotts spoke with Mr. Mullin, he noted that Mr. Mullin appeared to be impaired. Mr. Mullin was asked to exit his vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Mullin was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Mullin was charged with Under the Influence of CDS, DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain Lane, and Driving While Suspended. Mr. Mullin was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.
