On December 2, 2017 at 4:41 am, Officer Galop responded to Village Way in the area of building 61 for the report of a motor vehicle accident involving a 2012 Infiniti. When Officer Galop arrived, he observed the Infiniti off of the roadway to the left, which had struck two parked vehicles in the lot of building 61, after the vehicle has missed the turn into the lot from Village Way. Officer Galop made contact with the driver of the Infiniti, who was identified as Ms. Providence. As Officer Galop spoke with Ms. Providence he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage. Officer Galop asked Ms. Providence to exit the vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. During the course of the investigation Officer Galop noted that pieces of the Infiniti had been cleaned up off of the roadway, and placed in the back seat. Officer Galop also noted that the grass and dirt under the Infiniti was torn up, and ruts were made as Ms. Providence attempted to leave the scene prior to police arrival. Ms. Providence was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where she submitted to chemical breath testing. Ms. Providence was charged with DWI, DWI with a Minor Passenger, Failure to Report an Accident, Reckless Driving, Failure to Maintain Lane, Improper Turn, and Expired Driver's License. Ms. Providence was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On December 3, 2017 at 3:45 am, Officer Spotts was on routine patrol when he observed a 2006 Chrysler fail to maintain its lane of travel as it turned right onto Netcong Road from the parking lot of Kennedy's Pub. Officer Spotts initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Chrysler in the area of Abbot Street. Officer Spotts made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Collins. As Officer Spotts spoke with Ms. Collins she detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Ms. Collins appeared to be impaired. Ms. Collins was asked to exit her vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Ms. Collins was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where she submitted to chemical breath testing. Ms. Collins was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, and Failure to Maintain Lane. Ms. Collins was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

All parties listed above are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
