On December 8, 2017 at 9:03 pm, Officer Koppinger was on routine patrol when he observed a 2005 Pontiac traveling east on Rt. 46 traveling at a slow rate of speed, and failing to maintain its lane of travel. Officer Koppinger initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Pontiac just into Netcong, NJ. Officer Koppinger made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Parliman. As Officer Koppinger spoke with Ms. Parliman he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Ms. Parliman appeared to be impaired. Ms. Parliman was asked to exit her vehicle to perform field sobriety tests. Ms. Parliman was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where she submitted to chemical breath testing. Ms. Parliman was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, and Unregistered Motor Vehicle. Ms. Parliman was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On December 9, 2017 at 3:58 am, Officer Slinger responded to a residence on Madison Ave. for the report of suspicious activity. A caller reported to police that a male knocked on the door of their residence stating that his car was missing. When Officer Slinger arrived, he located the male, now seated in his vehicle on the side of the roadway. Officer Slinger made contact with the male, who was identified as Mr. Dudley. As Officer Slinger spoke with Mr. Dudley he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Dudley appeared to be impaired. Mr. Dudley was asked to exit his vehicle and perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Dudley was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where he submitted to chemical breath testing. Mr. Dudley was charged with DWI, Reckless Driving, Open Container of Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle, Failure to produce Driver's License, Failure to Produce Registration, and Failure to Produce Insurance Card. Mr. Dudley was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On December 9, 2017 at 7:27 am, Officer Carney responded to a residence in Eagle Rock Village for a noise complaint. When Officer Carney arrived, he made contact with the occupants of the residence, and a male inside was identified as Mr. Myrick. As Officer Carney spoke with Mr. Myrick he detected the odor of marijuana coming from inside of the residence. Once inside of the residence, Officer Carney observed a metal grinder and a plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana in plain view. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that the marijuana and paraphernalia belonged to Mr. Myrick. Mr. Myrick was placed under arrest, and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Myrick was charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Paraphernalia. Mr. Myrick was released pending a court hearing.

On December 9, 2017 at 4:49 pm, Detective Pagonis responded to Walmart for the report of shoplifting. Walmart Loss Prevention advised that one of their officers was following a female on foot who had attempted to leave the store with merchandise without paying. When Detective Pagonis arrived, he located the female in the area of Babies R Us. The female was identified as Ms. Bradley. A check of Ms. Bradley's credentials showed active warrants for Ms. Bradley's arrest totaling \$4,000.00 out of North Bergen and Totowa, NJ. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that Ms. Bradley was attempting to take merchandise totaling \$1,623.00 from the store. Ms. Bradley was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Bradley was charged with Shoplifting, and was subsequently lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.

On December 10, 2017 at 12:50 am, Officer Reynolds was on routine patrol when he observed a 2015 Mercedes Benz traveling west on Rt. 46 with its high beam headlights illuminated. Officer Reynolds initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Mercedes in the area of the Budd Lake Fire Department. Officer Reynolds made contact with the vehicle occupants, and a rear seat passenger was identified as Mr. Borbon. A check of Mr. Borbon's credentials showed an active warrant for Mr. Borbon's arrest for \$500.00 out of Alpine, NJ. Mr. Borbon was removed from the vehicle and placed under arrest. A search of Mr. Borbon's person yielded a large amount of cash in his pocket. Mr. Borbon was transported to police headquarters, where a secondary search yielded multiple baggies of suspected cocaine hidden on Mr. Borbon's person. Mr. Borbon was charged with Distribution of a Narcotic Drug, Possession of CDS Schedule I-IV, Transporting Property Known to be Derived from Criminal Activity, and Possession of Paraphernalia. Mr. Borbon was lodged in the Morris County Correctional Facility pending a court hearing.
