<b>Incident/Event:</b>	Possession of CDS, Possession of Paraphernalia, DWI
<b>Date:</b>	December 15, 2017
<b>Location:</b>	The Pavilion Sand Shore Road Budd Lake, NJ

<b>Involved:</b>	Ms. Dana S. Galla (A), 34 YO F, Budd Lake, NJ

On December 15, 2017 at 1:02 pm, Officer Elbaum was on routine patrol when he observed an occupied vehicle in the lot of the Pavilion. Officer Elbaum made contact with the vehicle occupants, and the driver was identified as Ms. Galla. As Officer Elbaum spoke with Ms. Galla, he noted that she appeared to be impaired. Ms. Galla was asked to exit the vehicle and perform field sobriety tests. During the course of the investigation it was determined that there were two ripped glassine folds in the vehicle, both containing suspected heroin residue. Ms. Galla was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. At headquarters, it was determined that Ms. Galla was in possession of a glassine baggie containing suspected heroin, and a ripped glassine baggie containing suspected heroin residue. Ms. Galla submitted to chemical breath testing and was subsequently charged with Possession of CDS Heroin, Possession of Paraphernalia, DWI, Under the Influence of CDS, Reckless Driving, and CDS in a Motor Vehicle. Ms. Galla was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

On December 16, 2017 at 11:49 pm, Officer Mullooly was on routine patrol when he observed a 2006 Pontiac turn right onto Rt. 206 North from Oakwood Drive with no functioning license plate lights. Officer Mullooly initiated a motor vehicle stop of the Pontiac in the area of Mooney Rd. Officer Mullooly made contact with the driver, who was identified as Ms. Rosamilla. As Officer Mullooly spoke with Ms. Rosamilla he detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. Ms. Rosamilla was asked to exit her vehicle, and a search was conducted. The search yielded a plastic gum container holding suspected marijuana and a partially smoked marijuana cigarette. Ms. Rosamilla was placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. Ms. Rosamilla was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, CDS in a Motor Vehicle, and Maintenance of Lamps. Ms. Rosamilla was released pending a court hearing.

On December 17, 2017 at 3:21 am, Officer Carletta responded to the intersection of Rt. 46 and International Drive South for the report of a traffic accident. When Officer Carletta arrived he observed a 2004 Ford and a 2006 BMW, both disabled in the roadway. Through the course of the investigation it was determined that the 2004 Ford, operated by Ms. Silva, failed to stop at the red traffic signal as it proceeded through the intersection on Rt. 46. The Ford struck the BMW as it made the left turn off of International Drive South onto Rt. 46 West. The driver of the BMW sustained injuries and was treated by the Budd Lake Rescue Squad, and transported to Hackettstown Medical Center for evaluation. The driver of the Ford was identified as Ms. Silva. Ms. Silva and her passenger as well as the passenger in the BMW were uninjured in the crash. Ms. Silva was asked to exit her vehicle and perform field sobriety tests. Ms. Silva was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters, where she submitted to chemical breath testing. Ms. Silva was charged with Assault by Auto, DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Stop, Careless Driving, Obstructed View, Failure to Provide Insurance Card, and Failure to Exhibit Vehicle Registration. Ms. Silva was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.

<b>Date:</b>	December 17, 2017
<b>Location:</b>	Tinc Road Flanders, NJ

<b>Involved:</b>	Mr. Stanislav Y. Golenkov (A), 32 YO M, Flanders, NJ

On December 17, 2017 at 11:31 pm, Officer Carletta responded to Tinc Rd. in the area of Neil Drive for the report of a single car motor vehicle crash involving a 2012 Jeep, which struck a tree. Officer Carletta made contact with the driver, who was identified as Mr. Golenkov. Mr. Golenkov was observed upon Officer Carletta's arrival to be cleaning up debris from the scene, placing it in the rear of the Jeep. Mr. Golenkov was uninjured in the crash. As Officer Carletta spoke with Mr. Golenkov he detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage, and Mr. Golenkov appeared to be impaired. Mr. Golenkov was asked to perform field sobriety tests. Mr. Golenkov was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to police headquarters. Mr. Golenkov refused to submit to chemical breath testing and was charged with DWI, refusal to Submit to Chemical Breath Testing, Reckless Driving, Failure to Report an Accident, Failure to Maintain Lane, and Careless Driving. Mr. Golenkov was released to a sober driver pending a court hearing.
