Officer Carson Parrott has been released from the field training program and has assumed full patrol duties.

Chief Stephen Beecher said that all police academy graduates must complete the field training program.

The field training program generally lasts three months and rookie officers must successfully meet 597 training objectives that cover a multitude of police activities, laws, policies and procedures, according to a statement from Chief Stephen Beecher.

Parrott's Field Training Officer was Detective David Hering.

Parrott is a 2011 graduate of Pope John High School. In 2015 he graduated Monmouth University in West Long Branch, New Jersey with a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice. On July 5, 2016, he was hired by the Sussex County Sheriff's Office and assigned to the Courts and Transportation Unit. Parrott graduated the Morris County Public Safety Academy on November 22, 2016.
