Officer Gregory Slinger has been released from the Field Training Program and has assumed full patrol duties this past week.

Chief Stephen Beecher said that all police academy graduates must complete the field training program.

The field training program generally lasts three months and rookie officers must successfully meet 597 training objectives that cover a multitude of police activities, laws, policies and procedures, according to a statement from Chief Stephen Beecher.

Slinger's Field Training Officer was Patrolman Chad Rossy.

Slinger is a 2005 graduate of Roxbury High School. Following high school, he attended The County College of Morris; receiving an Associate of Arts Degree in Social Sciences. He then attended Centenary University in Hackettstown, graduating in 2011 with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and Management. He worked as a Communications Officer with the Mount Olive Township Police Department from June of 2015 until his hire as a Police Officer. He was appointed to that position by Mayor Robert Greenbaum on January 14, 2017. Officer Slinger graduated the Morris County Public Safety Training Academy on May 31, 2017. He is presently assigned to the Patrol Division.
